Global delegates gathered in Charlotte, NC to prayerfully discern the work before them beginning April 23 for the postponed 2020 General Conference of the United Methodist Church. That work concluded and the General Conference was adjourned last Friday. We have provided some resources on our website for your review at your convenience at www.calhounfirst.com/general-conference.

Some key items included:

- 1) Approving a regionalization plan (now needing to be approved by 2/3 of Annual Conferences) to allow for more effective kingdom building in our varied contexts. This offers local churches and the Annual Conferences greater authority in kingdom matters going forward.
- 2) Revisions to our Social Principles (including racism, human dignity, care for the world, other social and economic matters of daily life). These principles, while not church law, reflect on our character and how we might better lead the church in our context.
- 3) Removal of restrictive language related to LGBTQIA+ people. This includes local churches, like ours, deciding whether or not to host weddings of LGBTQIA+ individuals (currently not allowed at CFUMC per our wedding policy). Clergy will also have the authority to preside over or refuse to preside over such services. Churches will continue to work with our Conference's leadership regarding clergy appointments in the future.
- 4) A variety of other decisions, such as changes in the budget process, lower apportionments, and Deacons being given sacramental authority, among others.

You will find more information through the resources mentioned above on our website. Church leadership will also be reviewing and evaluating more details as they become available in the coming months. You can call the office with questions and I or another of our leaders will try to answer the best we can with the information we have. <u>Christmas in July</u> will be here before you know it. We are collecting two items with a goal of at least 100 of each. The items to be collected and dates are below:


