- Established 1986
- Awarded to one student seeking a bachelor's or higher degree
- First preference is given to a member of Calhoun First UMC and secondly to a student in the United Methodist Church
- Determining factors
 - Member or close affiliation with Calhoun First UMC or other United Methodist Church
 - Scholastic aptitude (grades, test scores)
 - Financial need
 - Career goals

James Luke and Edna Spink Scholarship

- Established 1996
- Intended for one student with a documented learning disability that is also a Gordon County Student
- Determining factors
 - Average scholastic aptitude
 - Financial need

Frank and Mary Wills Stephens Memorial Scholarship

- Established 2010
- Awarded to students seeking a bachelor's or higher degree
- First preference is given to a member of Calhoun First UMC and secondly to a student in the United Methodist Church
- Preference is also given to Gordon County, GA residents
- Determining factors
 - Scholastic aptitude (grades, test scores)
 - Financial need

L.P. Owens Music Scholarship

- Established 2009
- First preference is given to a member of Calhoun First UMC and secondly to a student in the United Methodist Church
- Awarded to high school senior with musical interest and participation in some aspect of music in their church

Kyle Smith Scholarship

- Established by the Serendipity Sunday School class for Kyle's many years of service as their teacher
- Recipient must be a member of Calhoun First UMC
- Recipient must be a graduating high school senior
- If no such applications are submitted, this scholarship may be awarded to a present college student.
